An Open Letter

To:

Ministers and MKs who love the Land of Israel

Tomorrow, you will be called upon to ratify the agreement that was signed between Israel and the United Arab Emirates (the Abraham Accords).

Our movement and its supporters are calling upon you, as those who are loyal to and love the Land of Israel, to conduct a serious, thorough, and transparent deliberation in which clear answers will be demanded regarding several issues surrounding the agreement:

- The implications of paragraphs 8 and 9 in the agreement. In these paragraphs there appears a commitment to promote negotiations with the PA regarding "the legitimate needs and aspirations of both peoples." Does this constitute Israeli agreement to the two-state plan and a commitment to the Deal of the Century?
- The security implications of the paragraphs of the agreement and approval of the American sale of F-35 stealth bombers to the Emirates.
- The preferential or exclusive rights that the agreement gives to the UAE on the Temple Mount.
- Full transparency of the agreement's classified paragraphs prior to the vote.
- Its implications regarding the postponement/delay/abrogation of Israeli policy regarding the application of sovereignty in Judea and Samaria.
- Demand that the text of the agreement with Bahrain will also be disclosed to you.

We are all aware of the significance of the strong friendship between the Israeli government and the American administration. This friendship contributes greatly to Israel's standing, to the struggle against the Iranian nuclear program, and to Israel's security might. However, at the same time, we must not allow the upcoming US elections to serve as a factor pressuring the leadership of Israel to accept programs that will harm Israel's future and the Zionist vision.

The agreement in question is liable to have critical significance regarding the continued existence of the Jewish people in its land. As those who are well aware of the importance of your role as representatives of the national camp and of the entire Jewish people, we ask that you conduct a frank, fundamental deliberation, even though the primary issue which is currently monopolizing the attention of the Israeli public, its leadership, and, indeed, of the entire world is coping with the Corona virus.

Demand a clear and well-defined formulation of the Israeli agreements and commitments. Ambiguous formulations are liable to form the basis for future Israeli capitulations to another American administration or Israeli government that is not, God forbid, from the national camp.

Stand steadfast on your ideological position to prevent establishment of a Palestinian state in the heart of our homeland. This is your public mission, and on its basis you will be judged!
