We are living in confusing times.

The composition of the government entails some significant risks for the settlement enterprise, the Jewish identity of the State of Israel and the future of the Land of Israel. However, we must be thankful for every nationalist, sovereign and Land-of-Israel step, and just as we praised the resolute statement made by the Minister of Interior Security that the Flag March would proceed in the heart of Jerusalem, and that our enemies would not determine what happens in Jerusalem, we also must praise, albeit guardedly, the agreement that is expected to lead to the regularization of Evyatar.

For more than a half-century, the settlement in Judea and Samaria has known agreements and accords that have led, ultimately, to the establishment of many flourishing towns, which today, have thousands of residents, but as in every other case, the true test is the result. If this test results in the establishment of a town, the entire process is praiseworthy.

Regarding Evyatar, we must carefully examine the government's steps and assure that indeed, they will produce a new town on the map of Israel. Knowing the settler activists and the organizations that have worked on the agreement and are signed on it, it seems that we may be able to count on steps being taken to assure the establishment of the town.

We must praise and admire the dedication of the residents of Evyatar in establishing the town and strengthening our hold on the soil of the Land of Israel. Your deeds, dear and wonderful pioneers, are a wonderful example and banner to all of us and for the coming generations.

Israel's past political experience informs us that Caroline's dark predictions have come true in the past and it is important for us to become familiar with these increasingly disturbing details and facts.

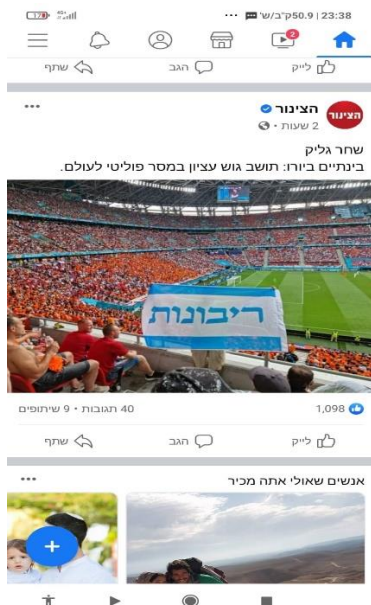
